- C. Jr. High Report (Miguel Cabrera)

Slow brass etude has changed as per region vote last spring. We are in even year. Music was handed out, but it has also been posted online.

- D. Jazz Report (Jason Howard)

Music is available. Explained cuts and fees associated. September 10<sup>th</sup> is the date of auditions.

Junior high region music is also available. Patterns given to students for drumset part. Recordings due February 1<sup>st</sup>.

Point of information made that you must renew your ATSSB and TMEA dues prior to entering auditions.

- E. Mariachi Report (Jessie Rios and Gerald Ledesma )

After spring region meeting directors met and came up with music for Mariachi's four groups. Jaime Vela helped out to find music, but was not commissioned to write. \$100/song plus tracks available. 20 songs needed. Mariachi finished \$1,700 in black last year.

HM King High in December for auditions. Groups meet in January. Details

Campus fee of \$30 in addition to entry fee per student. Entries are done online through TMEA.org.

- F. Area South Coordinator (Emerico Perez)

We're on year A. At region there are cuts, there are no cuts at Area beyond state cuts.

At Area you also play all scales 1-8 there must be a break of 4 counts between scales. Monitor is not to remind students of missed scales.

Please check out the holding room guidelines. 2 Rooms in the Flute, Clarinet, Trumpet, and Percussion rooms for 1A-3A and then 4A. Everything else is done in one room.

When you're typing your students **DO NOT USE ALL CAPS** on entries.

No money is needed at Area for Region 14 as the region pays the dues.

**Motion to use Region 14 funds to provide food for the directors for contest, money is reimbursed by the state, Kenneth Thurman, Jason Howard seconded. Approved by Acclimation.**

G. Website Coordinator (Steven Rash)

H. UIL Coordinator (Bill Cason)

Welcome given, questions or concerns for UIL contact him.

Please excuse him for not keeping new schools strange.

All dates were approved by Executive Committee, all entry fees are the same as well.

Rules updated in regards to late fees for paying late, and withdrawing from UIL Contests. Reprimand and a late fee of \$50 will be assessed to each organization that does not comply with the deadline. If fees are not paid by day of contest the students will be allowed to perform, but awards will be held until the fees are paid. And the late fee will increase to \$100.

Clause removed from rule book: "Penalty for withdrawing from music contest."

Any music organization in region 14 must notify executive secretary no later than 4:00pm one day prior to the first day of the competition. This must come from a campus or district administrator. Electronic notification, such as email or text, is considered acceptable. No reason needs to be given for withdrawal, no refunds will be given.

Explanation given by Bill as far as the reasoning. Your responsibility to have checks on time, not just business office.

Other rule changes:

A lot of it is housekeeping items, C&CR has been cleaned up and downsized.

Limitations on award has been removed. Schools no longer are banned from receiving pay

No requirements for enrollment in classes to participate in bands must be in class.

Students may perform in two bands if they meet requirements for two different instruments. Chart will be available online. Like instruments like Flute/Piccolo, Clarinet/Bass Clarinet, are not different enough.

New school or new program, request made to State Office may be Non-Varsity and may still maintain Non-Varsity status even though they've received a Superior at contest may delay the move to Varsity with approval from state office.

Rest of rule changes are online.

Jaime Vela brought up entry flow plans at Marching Contest, bands will setup on Endzone while their preceding band is performing. 2 Front Ensembles will be cued up on Track.

#### I. TMEA Coordinator (Carlos Luna)

Creating a rubric for Solo and Ensemble has been approved for UIL Solo and Ensemble. Will be approved Summer of 2017.

Classifications of magnet schools has changed as well.

The two proposals submitted by ATSSB Region 14 have so far only been responded to by UIL with discussion. It will become an action item in the spring and be voted on then at the 2017 Spring Meeting. Website will have information on process of selection of members.

**B. REGION BAND CLINIC/CONCERT**

ATSSB Region Coordinators MUST include the following in their agendas for their fall region meetings and may need to print a handout that includes these items in addition to regional issues not addressed here. Be sure to update Region Coordinator contact information with the State Office, especially if there is a change. Please note that the TMEA online entry process includes a 3A All-State Track (all students in Class 1A and 2A and 3A are automatically in the 3A Track unless they submit a Track Selection with their initial entry selecting another track: 4A, 5A, or 6A). You will receive an email from TMEA when you may set up your contests online. Remember to view the video tutorials offered you regarding setting up contests. Be especially careful to watch the tutorials regarding jazz recorded entries this year (no CDs). Entry deadlines are standard statewide with penalties for late entries-and all are built into the online entry process and may not be changed:

- 1) All contests deadlines will be 14 days prior to the audition.
- 2) The late and final online student entry will be 7 days prior to the day of audition.
- 3) Correction to an existing student entry may be made between 13 and 7 days prior to the audition without penalty, but any student entry added less than 14 days but more than 7 days prior to the contest will result in an additional 100% student late fee.
- 4) Entries begun less than 14 but more than 7 days prior to the contest will be assessed a 50% additional CAMPUS fee charge and 100% student fee charge.
- 5) A CAMPUS entry created less than 14 days prior to the contest will be subject to the TMEA Grievance Process.
- 6) Directors will be allowed to add or change student entries the day of the audition if region rules allow it. The 50% additional CAMPUS and 100% additional student late fees will be assessed.
- 7) All fees must be paid or supported by a school purchase order prior to the start of auditions.
- 8) Remember – Do NOT delete DNAs – you may OMIT them but do not DELETE them. TMEA needs the data.
- 9) If a director has knowledge that a student will not be able to participate in the Region Band or at Area auditions, he/she must contact the Region Coordinator at the earliest possible time.

- 10) Every effort will be made to make directors aware of replacements as soon as possible.
- 11) The region coordinator and band organizer will seat alternates. Directors and clinicians will not make those decisions.
- 12) Each student's director (or a qualified proxy) MUST be in attendance at the rehearsals to assist the clinicians and assist in supervising his/her students.

**I.** Be aware of housing procedures at all-state (Hyatt Regency) and that students must bring a wire stand to state.

**K.** Note that at All-State Chair auditions, no electronic devices shall be allowed in the audition room other than tuners and metronomes (no cell phones or mp3 players or iPods - if found, these will be taken up until after auditions); however, students may use electronic media in lieu of printed music (a book is still provided on the stand for student use) so long as the media does not conflict with existing rules governing electronic devices as listed above.

### Rules

- A. Student eligibility rules will be based on current UIL Rules of Eligibility. Any director entering student must be a current member of ATSSB and TMEA prior to auditions.
